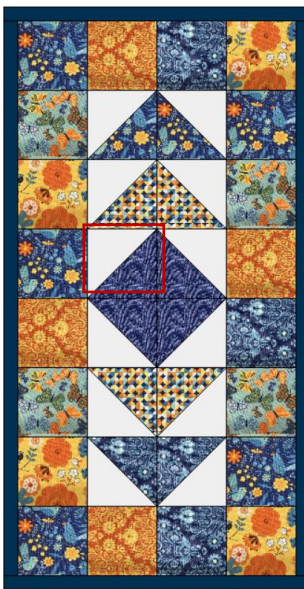











Table Runner #1

(approx.. 17" x 33")

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1. Cut 20 outer blocks 4.5" x 4.5" (or use a charm pack squares that you cut down from 5" square to 4.5" square)
2. Cut 6 light (or white fabric) and 6 dark (or print fabric) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8". These will be for your half square triangles. Again, you can cut down charm squares.
3. To make half square triangles, place a LIGHT 4 7/8" square on top of a DARK 4 7/8" square. (If you are NOT using batik fabric, make sure to put right sides are together.) Draw a line on the LIGHT fabric from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (diagonal line) with a pencil. You will sew 1/4" on EACH side of your marked solid line. See the dotted lines in the diagram to the below.
4. After sewing and quilting, cut 4 strips for binding 2.5" wide
